


What I Need To Have Ready

Debate Layout

ROUND ONE Introduction of Group-Who are you? What are your basic beliefs? What do you think should happen? <u>1-2 Sentences Per Question;</u> <u>No Rebuttals</u>

ROUND TWO Go more in depth on your beliefs. This is where you will begin to answer some of the Essential Questions! Give some of your good stuff, but don't give away all of you best stuff quite yet!) <u>2-3 minutes; Still No Rebuttals</u>

ROUND THREE It's On Like Donkey Kong! Groups can go back and forth in a civilized manner. Usually for strongest debater and where you would use some of your most powerful evidence!

ROUND FOUR ALL OUT WAR! You are not your assigned person anymore. You can now show YOUR opinion!
